The statewide six

These six materials can now be recycled everywhere in Vermont. But even that causes questions, so here are examples of what can/ can't go into the bins.

1

Paper

Magazines, Newspapers, Mail, Catalogs, Phone books, and Mixed paper

but not... Paper towels, Soft tissues, Hardcover books



2

Aluminum

Cans, Foil, Pie Tins & Trays

but not... Aluminum siding, Scrap metal, Pots or Pans



3

Cardboard

Dry & clean cardboard, Cereal and Cracker boxes

but not... Juice cartons, Frozen food containers, Greasy pizza boxes



4

Steel

Cans (including tin), Lids, Empty Aerosol cans

but not... Major appliances, Scrap metal, Pesticide sprays, Paint cans



5

Glass

Beer bottles, Wine bottles, Mason jars

but not... Window glass, Light bulbs, Ceramic dishes



6

Hard Plastics

Water/soda bottles (remove caps please), Milk jugs, Shampoo bottles

but not... Plastic bags, Styrofoam, Large plastic toys
