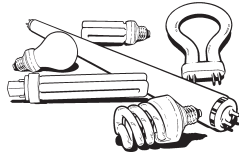


# Recycle Fluorescent Bulbs Year-Round!

## Tips for Traveling With Bulbs Safely

Follow these simple guidelines:

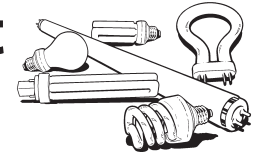
- Package spent fluorescent bulbs carefully. Wrap them in bubble wrap or other packing material, and place them in a container so they won't roll around and be at risk of breaking.
