## Appointment of District Clerk (6)

After 11 years, Barb Baird has resigned from the position of Board Clerk. The resignation is not to be confused with her job as Office Manager – which she retains. The Charter change now allows a board member to be appointed to the position.

Bill Powell moved to appoint Peter Carbee, Washington representative, as Board Clerk. The motion was seconded.

Carbee explained that he will take on the position on an interim basis and will keep the board appraised on the end date.

**The motion passed unanimously.** The board thanked Baird and Carbee.

#### FY 19 School Zero Waste Program Addendum (9)

Brenna Toman, School Zero Waste Coordinator, detailed the proposed changes to the School Zero Waste Program resulting from an award of EPA funding.

Anita Krauth moved to accept the changes to the School Zero Waste Program. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

#### FY 19 Budget Revisions (10)

a. Adjust FY 19 Capital Plan for pickup truck replacement

Bruce Westcott explained the request for the Board to authorize a capital expenditure for \$25,000 for a replacement pickup truck, currently planned for FY '20.

Peter Carbee moved to authorize the expenditure of \$25,000 from the FY '20 budget for a replacement pickup truck providing the use of old cap and at least 3 vendor quotes. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

b. Adjust FY 19 Budget to incorporate EPA Healthy Communities Grant funding of \$25,000. Bruce Westcott explained that the grant funding will be reflected in both FY 19 and FY 20 budgets. The FOC approved the revision before the Board meeting.

Peter Carbee moved to amend the FY 19 budget to reflect the grant funding. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

#### Preliminary FY 20 Budget (11)

- a. Approval of FY 20 Per Capita Assessment
- b. Approval of FY 20 Operating Budget
- c. Approval of FY 20 Capital Budget

Bruce Westcott went over the reports in the packet and answered questions.

Bill Powel moved to approve to sustain the Per Capita Assessment at \$1.00 for FY 20. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Bill Powell moved to approve the FY 20 Operating Budget. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Bill Powell moved to approve the FY 20 Capital Budget. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
