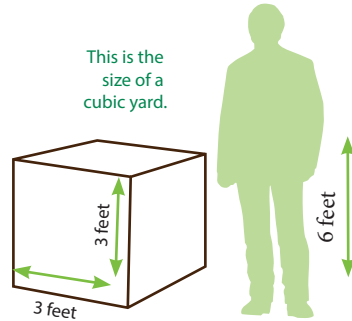

ARCC FACILITY FEE

*Cash or check only

Any combination of the following items are accepted by the following fees by volume:

Per 5 gallon - \$2
Up to 1/2 cubic yard - \$8
Per cubic yard - \$16



- Documents for secure shredding
- Plastic film (clean, stretchy, not compostable or crinkly, #2 and #4 only)
- Scrap metal (up to 4 ft)
 - Cookware
 - Metal caps and lids
 - Jewelry
 - Other metal items
- Textiles (clean, odorless, and dry)
 - Bags
 - Belts
 - Clothing
 - Hats
 - Shoes
 - Towels
- Wires, Cords, Cables, and Adaptors

NO FEES FOR RESIDENTS!

The following items are covered under Vermont's Extended Producer Responsibility Programs:

- **Household Batteries** up to 11 lbs. and under 300Wh.
- **TVs, computers, and computer peripherals** such as monitors, desktop printers and scanners, and ink and toner cartridges. Fees may apply to some non-residential customers with more than seven devices.
- **Household paint, stain, and tile sealer** (no marine/automotive paint, solvents, or spray paint).
- **Fluorescent bulbs and tubes:** 10 or fewer tubes and unlimited CFLs are free; fee of \$0.15/foot applies to more than 10 non-CFL tubes.
- **Mercury containing thermostats**

ITEMS WITH INDIVIDUAL FEES

*Cash or check only

- **Automotive/lead acid batteries (more than 11 lbs.)** \$2 each
- **CFC units** \$20 each
- **Cooking oil** \$2 for less than 5 gallons, \$3.50 per 5 gallon
- **Damaged or swollen lithium batteries (up to 11 lbs. and under 300Wh)** \$4 each
- **Electronics, up to 50 lbs** \$1-\$15 each (no large wooden electronics)
- **Fire extinguishers** \$3.50 each
- **Fluorescent & LED light ballasts (removed from fixture)** \$4 each
- **Food scraps** \$2 for less than 5 gallons, \$3.50 per 5 gallon
- **High watt-hour lithium batteries (300 - 800 WH)** \$25 - \$100 each
- **Light bulbs** \$.50 - \$4 each (no neon)
- **Mercury Devices** \$4
- **Non-wood stereo speakers** \$5 each for less than 24", \$10 each for more than 24" (no wooden speakers)
- **Propane tanks** \$1 for 1 lb, \$3 for 20 - 30 lb
- **Smoke detectors** \$5 - \$10 each
- **Vacuums (full-sized)** \$5.00 each
- **Vape pens (no cartridge)** \$2 each
